## Nomination form for Committee Election

The Society Committee is elected for 12 months, this period running from April to March, and a new committee must be elected at the start of the AGM at the first meeting in April. In the case that a vacancy arises during the Club Year, nominations will be required for a mid-term election. Members elected at an interim election are in post until the following AGM.

Members of the Society are invited to submit nominations using this form. Proposers and Nominees must be paid up members of the Society for the current Society Membership year.

Current members of the Committee may be nominated to serve a further term, but are regarded as being nominated by virtue of being in post.

When you have completed the nomination form, please hand it to a member of the current committee as soon as possible.

If you wish to nominate someone, they have to be willing to undertake the tasks involved. Both the proposer and nominee must sign the form.

Committee members are expected to attend ca. four committee meetings per year. These are usually held in June, September, December and March of each Society year, the venue being the hall on the first meeting of these months. It is expected that you be a regular participant at the society meetings, as it is possible that you may be asked to be a “keyholder” responsible for opening and closing the hall.
